



Joshua Dodgson had led the breakaway movement from Elland Wesley in 1850. His son Jonathan became one of the Trustees of the new buildings at Southgate which were opened in 1891 (now the Southgate Christian Centre) but he did not live to see the stone-laying of the new church in 1914.

Joshua had died in 1870 aged 75, and Jonathan died in 1909 aged 88.

Emily Dodgson, Jonathan's daughter laid this stone in memory of her father and grandfather. She died in 1929.
