



Harriett Dyson was married to Sam Dyson, a soap manufacturer. Sam owned Atlas Works in South Lane, the business having been started by his father James. The family were stalwart members of the United Methodist Church, Southgate. Elland: Sam was a Trustee and his wife a member of the Ladies' Visitation Committee.

They lived at Lyndhurst, a large house in Victoria Road (on the corner of Recreation Lane). It is now a care home, run by the NHS.
